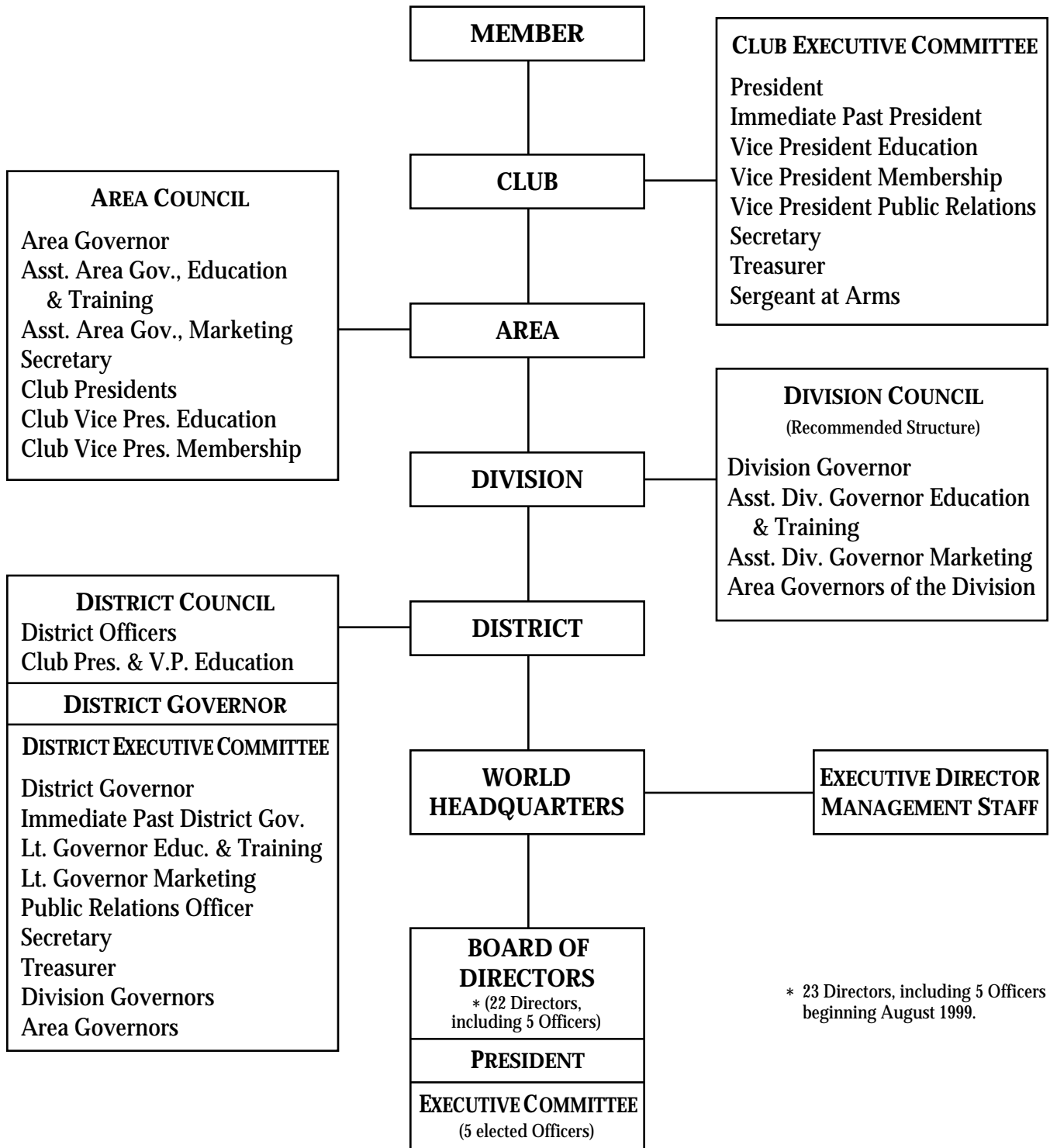


TOASTMASTERS INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATION SERVICE CHART

This chart traces the flow of services, material, and programs upward from the Board of Directors through the various echelons of Toastmasters International to the ultimate beneficiary, the individual member.

MEMBER

TOASTMASTERS CLUB

The Mission of the Club: The mission of a Toastmasters Club is to provide a mutually supportive and positive learning environment in which every member has the opportunity to develop communication and leadership skills, which in turn foster self-confidence and personal growth.

The Club is the stockholder and voting member of Toastmasters International.

AREA

An Area, lead by an Area Governor, provides support to clubs (usually 4 - 6 clubs in a geographic area).

The Area Governor is responsible for conducting Area Council meetings, visiting clubs in the Area twice a year, holding Area Contests and assisting the clubs.

Area Council consists of Area Gov., Assistant Area Gov., Secretary, Club Pres., Club Vice-pres. Education, Club Vice-pres. Membership. Meetings are held on a regular basis

DIVISION

Areas are grouped into Divisions, lead by a Division Governor
The Division Governor is responsible for conducting Division Council meetings, holding Division Contests, helping build new clubs and assisting the Area Governors.

Division Council consists of Division Gov., Assistant Division Gov. and Area Gov.

DISTRICT

The Mission of the District: The mission of the District is to enhance the performance and extend the network of Clubs, thereby offering greater numbers of people the opportunity to benefit from the Toastmasters educational program by

- *Focusing on the critical success factors as specified by the District educational and membership goals*
- *Insuring the each Club effectively fulfills its responsibilities to its members*
- *Providing effective training and leadership development opportunities for Club and District officers*

The District Officers have numerous functions that they are responsible for in order to meet the above mission and provide service to the member of the District.

District Council consists of District Executive, Club Pres. and Club Vice-pres.. The Club Pres. and Club Vice-Pres. Education can designate a written proxy to another club member if they are not going to attend (exception to this is that they can collect each others ballots without a written proxy). The District Executive must be present to vote. The District Council meets twice a year at the District Conferences.

The District Executive consists of District Gov., Lt. Gov. Education & Training, Lt. Gov. Marketing, Inm. Past DG, Public Relations Officer, Sec., Treas., Division Govs. & Area Governors

REGION

Region is not part of the organization chart - it exists to nominate members to the International Board of Directors, to conduct an International Speech Contest and to train District Officers (District Governor, Lt. Governor Education & Training, Lt. Governor Marketing).

INTERNATIONAL

Toastmasters International Vision: Toastmasters International empowers people to achieve their full potential and realize their dreams. Through our member Clubs, people throughout the world can improve their communication and leadership skills, giving them the courage to change.

The policy-making body of the organization consists of a Board of Directors and an Executive Committee. The Board of Directors is lead by the International President.

The staff, headed by an Executive Director, at World Headquarters takes care of the administration of the organization.
